Drew	Rachel; born in Boonville, Missouri; died 29 Apr 1919 in Saline Township, Cooper County, Missouri; buried 30 Apr 1919; mother born in Kentucky; widow; black; informant Andy Drew, Overton, Missouri
Duncan	Caroline née Drew; born 17 Jan 1883 in Cooper County, Missouri; died 10 Feb 1916 in Saline Township, Cooper County, Missouri; buried 11 Feb 1916; daughter of Andy (born Cooper County, Missouri) and Lucinda née Taylor Drew (born Cooper County, Missouri); married; housewife; black; informant Andy Drew, Boonville, Missouri
