History:

Recorded by Mrs. Harold T. Embry. This cemetery probably is not in Cooper County but, in Linn Township, in Moniteau County. These burials are recorded in the files in Cooper County Courthouse, Boonville, Missouri.

This cemetery is on land now owned by Mr. Jack Oerly of Jamestown, Missouri; probably in Linn Township. At one time there was a road, but it has now been closed. So to reach this spot one must walk about a quarter of a mile.
