Nothing remains of this burial plot; there was only one stone, as far as anyone can recall. Thomas McMahan, Sr. was the father of Thomas, Jr., Samuel, and James McMahan, all original settlers of Lamine Township, Cooper County, Missouri. - Taken from "History of Cooper County Missouri" by W.
