**History:**

This list recorded by Mr. Nixon in January 1967. There are two marked graves and possibly two unmarked grave. John Pursley was among the soldiers of Captain Sarshell Cooper's Company in April of 1812. He was also among the earliest settlers of Saline Township, Cooper County, Missouri.
