

Will of Job McClanahan

The last Will & Testament of Jobe McClanahan Oct. 19th 55

In the name of God. Amen. I Jobe McClanahan of the county of Cooper and State of Missouri, being of sound mind, though of great bodily lability, do make and declare this to be my last Will and Testament.

I give and bequeath to Mary Manely's (my daughter) heirs namely, James Manely, Job Manely & William A. Manely five dollars each. To my son James McClanahan's heirs namely Liddy Ann McClanahan, Emmaline McClanahan & Martha Minerva McClanahan I give the sum of five dollars each. To my son David McClanahan's heirs namely Elizabeth McClanahan, Crecy Ann McClanahan, & Mary Francis McClanahan, I give five dollars each.

To my son Thomas McClanahan I give the sum of fifty dollars. To my daughter Caroline Davis I give the sum of fifty dollars. To my son Jackson McClanahan I give the sum of fifty dollars. To my daughter Elizabeth Rimal I give the sum of fifty dollars. To my son Job S. McClanahan I give fifty dollars. To my daughter Crecy Ann McClanahan I give the sum of one hundred dollars. To my daughter Liddy Rimall [sic] I give the sum of fifty dollars. I wish my son Job S. McClanahan my daughter Crecy Ann McClanahan to have all of the crop made on my farms this year 1855. The balance of my estate real & personal, I wish, after my medical bills & funeral expenses, are paid, to be equally divided amongst my heirs as follows – namely – Thomas McClanahan, Caroline Davis, Jackson McClanahan,, Elizabeth Rimel, Job S. McClanahan, Crecy Ann McClanahan, & Liddy Rimel, to the exclusions of the heirs of my daughter Mary Manely James McClanahan & David McClanahan to whence, as above stated, I bequeath the sum of five dollars each.

It is my wish and desire that William Haushaer & Thomas McClanahan be my Executors. In testimony of the above will I affix my hand this 19th day of October 1855.
